

7. EXTREME HEAT DEACTIVATION

EXTREME HEAT EMERGENCY DEACTIVATION

TRIGGER

The ECCC will issue an alert ending the EXTREME Heat Emergency as determined by the BC Heat Committee and when current and forecasted weather no longer meet the EHE criteria:
Daytime maximum temperatures are forecasted to drop below 35°C AND/OR the overnight minimum temperature drops below 18°C

Checklist

- ☐ Issue extreme heat deactivation key messaging to staff, community partners, and the public
 - ☐ De-activate cooling centres
 - ☐ Community cooling services
 - ☐ De-activate free shuttle / public transportation to cooling centres or cool public spaces
 - ☐ Confirm financial recovery through EMCR is underway
 - ☐ Deactivate EOC
 - ☐ Conduct a hotwash and debrief
 - ☐ Consider scheduling an AAR
